



1. SCOPE OF WORK

a) Obligations of the Institute

- **PET CT Machine Provision:** The Institute will provide one PET-CT machine (128 slice), which shall be operated and maintained by the Service Provider, who shall ensure maintenance support through the equipment manufacturer during the initial warranty period of five (5) years.
- **Furniture:** The Institute will provide available furniture; maintenance will be the responsibility of the service provider.
- **Utility Services:** The Institute will ensure the provision of electricity and water supply
- **Power Backup:** Dedicated UPS backup shall be provided to ensure uninterrupted operation of the PET-CT machine
- **Equipment Servicing:** M/s Wipro GE Healthcare Pvt. Ltd. shall carry out periodic servicing of the PET-CT equipment as per the applicable warranty terms.

b) Obligations of the Service Provider

I. Initiation of the Service

1. The Service Provider shall operate and maintain a fully functional Digital PET/CT Scan Machine (Model: Omni Legend, Make: GE Healthcare) under the PPP model, ensuring compliance with all applicable regulatory requirements including AERB guidelines. The Service Provider shall provide high-quality services with minimal waiting time, ensure patient and personnel safety at all times, and adhere to all applicable standards relating to medical devices, radiation safety, and data privacy governing the operation of digital PET/CT systems in India. .
2. The Service Provider shall be responsible for obtaining all mandatory approvals and permits, including civil, electrical, and radiation safety clearances, in coordination with and with facilitation from the Institute authorities.
3. The Service Provider shall install a Gallium Generator at the site for supporting PSMA and DOTA scans
4. The Institute shall permit the Service Provider to undertake interior alterations only, if rooms are provided for locating the equipment as per AERB regulations. All interior modifications and upgradation of facilities required for the project shall be carried out entirely at the Service Provider's own cost.
5. A comprehensive list of required drugs and consumables, along with specifications, shall be submitted at least 30 days prior to commencement of services.
6. The service provider shall nominate a dedicated technical point of contact responsible for PET CT system performance, maintenance, and coordination with the Institute's technical staff. The nominated personnel shall possess appropriate expertise in digital PET CT technology. (Annexure M)

II. Progress and Continuity of the Service

7. The PET CT Scan investigation facility will have to function for patient care round the clock (i.e. 12hrs per day, 7 days per week, 365 days a year) with an uptime of 95% per annum. Services shall be operational on all working days and shifts up to **8:00 PM**, or as decided by the Competent authority.

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8. Upon completion of the initial five-year warranty period, the responsibility for the Comprehensive Annual Maintenance Contract (CAMC) of the equipment shall be taken over by the Service Provider and shall remain in force for the entire contract period to ensure uninterrupted operation of scan services. The Service Provider shall periodically report compliance of the CAMC to the HOD Nuclear medicine/Officer appointed by the Competent Authority.
9. Any damage arising during operation of the PET-CT equipment within the warranty period shall be rectified by the equipment manufacturer as per warranty terms. Any damage or fault not covered under the manufacturer's warranty shall be the responsibility of the Service Provider.
10. Purchase, Installation and Maintenance etc., of all the equipment & accessories not bundled with the installed PET CT Machine will be under the scope of Service Provider.
11. The Service Provider shall be responsible for regular monitoring of availability of consumables and shall ensure effective coordination and collaboration with the FIC-HRF and FIC-Radiodiagnosis to avoid any disruption in services.
12. The Service Provider shall manage stocks and inventories as per operational requirements and Institute guidelines.
13. The Service Provider shall ensure complete data security, privacy, storage, and backup for a minimum of five (05) years. Any data breach shall be treated as a serious contractual violation.
14. Procurement, safe handling, storage, and disposal of radiopharmaceuticals shall be the sole responsibility of the Service Provider, in accordance with applicable regulations.
15. Standard, safe, and approved-brand disposables (such as syringes, gloves, scalp vein sets, extension tubings, Viggo/Veflon, etc.) shall ordinarily be made available through the **Hospital Revolving Fund (HRF)** on a **payment basis by the patient**.

III. Execution of the Service

16. The Service Provider shall be responsible for comprehensive PET-CT imaging services, including system operation, maintenance, supply of consumables (unless exempted), deployment of qualified personnel, and adherence to the service schedule approved by the Institute.
17. Any medico-legal issues arising during or out of treatment of patients will be the responsibility of Service Provider
18. The PET/CT Services shall cater only to the patients registered at KSSSCI, Lucknow, and referred by KSSSCI doctors. Priority shall be given to emergency cases, critically ill patients, and admitted patients from various departments of KSSSCI.
19. KSSSCI shall provide electricity up to the main panel. Power consumption beyond the main panel shall be metered, and charges shall be billed to the Service Provider monthly. Generator backup power shall be provided during main power failures; however, fuel costs shall be borne by the Service Provider.
20. The Service Provider shall pay ₹1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lakh only) per month to the Hospital towards utilization of space, machine infrastructure.
21. Electricity consumption for running the PET-CT and related services will not be borne by the Institute.
Instead, the Service Provider will pay electricity charges separately, based on actual usage.
22. The technical staff, recruited by the Service Provider, should have the qualification specified by KSSSCI (Annexure-M). Any deviation from the same would be taken as a breach in agreement and be liable for suitable actions.
23. The Service provider shall submit an undertaking duly signed by the authorised signatory of the firm confirming deployment of suitably qualified and competent technologist capable of operating



the Digital PET CT Scan 128-slice system and its accessories. Any loss or damage to equipment or patients due to improper handling shall be the sole responsibility of the Service Provider (**Annexure-M**).

24. The Service Provider shall provide trained nursing staff as per qualifications specified in **Annexure-N**, along with a responsible person for patient coordination, monitoring, and smooth conduct of scans. The designated person may refuse a scan if the patient is critically unstable and no attending clinician is present
25. Before deployment of any manpower the service provider shall furnish:
 - a) Copy of letter of appointment issued to the deployed manpower carrying the signature of the incumbent.
 - b) An undertaking from the deployed manpower to the effect that he/she would not claim any rights to be an employee of the Institute on the basis of his/her deployment under the terms of the contract
26. The Service Provider is overall responsible for the good conduct and character of the manpower deployed. The Service Provider is expected to be duly diligent to carry out background check of each manpower before deploying it with the Institute and ensure that no criminal case is ongoing against any of the manpower deployed as and when they are deployed by the Service Provider in the Institute.

27. Manpower Requirements shall include:

- Nuclear Medicine Physician
- Nuclear Medicine Technologist
- Nursing Staff
- Data Entry Operator
- Hospital Attendant

The Service Provider shall be solely responsible for assessing the workload and deploying the requisite number of qualified manpower accordingly.

28. Adequate female nurses and attendants shall be deployed, particularly for female patients. A round-the-clock appointment scheduling and patient waiting-area management system shall be maintained to avoid overcrowding.
29. The cost of contrast media shall be charged separately from the patients by HRF, KSSSCI as per the approved rates.

IV. Reporting of the Service

30. PET-CT studies shall be reported by the Nuclear Medicine Physician deputed by the service provider during official working hours, limited to a maximum of fifteen (15) patients per day. However, in case of emergency or on exigent clinical need, the Service Provider shall ensure timely reporting beyond the stipulated limit, as required, to avoid any delay in patient care.
31. In case of emergency requirements, the Service Provider may arrange reporting services either through physical presence of a qualified Nuclear Medicine Physician or tele-reporting. However, the Department of Nuclear Medicine, KSSSCI shall not be responsible for routine review or validation of tele-reports generated by the Service Provider. The department of Nuclear Medicine, KSSSCI may undertake random validation of the reports for clinical reference, and the final interpretation, clinical acceptance, and treatment related decision making shall rest exclusively with the Faculty of Nuclear Medicine, KSSSCI.
32. Normal reporting turnaround time shall not be later than **two working days**.

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33. The Service Provider shall offer a DVD/pen drive and a minimum of two (2) CT films per PET scan report. All reports shall be retained on the cloud for the entire duration of the contract period. The image data shall thereafter be transferred to a secondary server, and copies of the same shall be provided to the Institute on a quarterly basis.

34. The Digital PET CT 128 slice facility shall allow faculty and residents of the referring department to have access to view PET CT scans of their respective patients for clinical management. However, the images will not be provided without the consent of the Nuclear Medicine department.

V. Wrong / Deficient Reporting

35. All PET-CT reports shall be subject to validation by the Faculty of Nuclear Medicine, KSSSCI at any point of time. Any report found to be incorrect, incomplete, or non-compliant with standard reporting protocols shall be treated as a deficient report.

36. The Service Provider shall review, rectify, and re-issue such reports within 48 hours of intimation, at no additional cost. Repeated deficiencies shall be treated as adverse events and may attract penalties, including warning, financial penalty, or de-empanelment of the concerned Nuclear Medicine Physician, as decided by the Competent Authority of the Institute.

37. Any suboptimal or poor-quality PET CT scans (e.g., due to poor counts, extravasation, patient movement, etc.), as assessed by the reporting physician, shall be repeated at no additional cost. Doubtful or incomplete studies shall be repeated only after review by the on-duty faculty.

VI. Charges, Rates & Data Security (Linked to Execution & Reporting)

38. All PET CT investigations shall be conducted at pre-approved rates fixed by KSSSCI, for all patient categories

39. Approved PET/CT investigation rates shall be inclusive of:

- Imaging films/colored glossy printouts and CD/DVD (average 2-3 printouts per patient), and
- An eco-friendly carry bag for reports and printouts

40. Contrast media shall be provided by the Hospital Revolving Fund (HRF), KSSSCI, and charged as per HRF-approved rates. No additional charges shall be levied for contrast-enhanced scans or images

41. All investigation rates shall be clearly displayed at the PET CT facility

42. Rendering scan services without charge is not permitted, except for cashless schemes approved by the Institute. Reimbursement responsibility shall lie with the Service Provider as per the protocol set by KSSSCI.

43. If a single adjacent contiguous region is deemed essential by the Nuclear Medicine faculty/resident, no additional charge shall be levied.

44. Any ambiguity related to charges shall be resolved amicably between the Head of the Department of Nuclear Medicine and the service provider. In unresolved cases, the matter shall be referred to the competent authority, KSSSCI.

2. INSTRUCTIONS TO SERVICE PROVIDER

- The Bidder shall have minimum three (03) years' of experience in operating a PET-CT scan facility during the last three consecutive financial years, i.e., FY 2022-23, 2023-24, and 2024-25, in a Government, Trust, or Private Hospital or The Service Provider should be running PET CT facility for atleast 3 years or more.
- Duly signed work completion/ End User certificate from organisation issued by Head of the institution/authorized person) must be attached with the bid. (**Annexure J**)

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- The bidder must provide **Performance Evaluation Report/ Satisfactory Report** from the existing organization/ Govt. / State Govt. / Central autonomous bodies/ State autonomous bodies / Central and State PSUs/Corporate institutions/organization which must be duly signed by the Head/ Authorized signatory of the organization
- The Bidder shall submit Income Tax Returns (ITR) and Profit & Loss (P/L) accounts for the last three consecutive financial years
- Net worth of the prospective Bidder must be positive as per the last audited financial statement. (CA Certified for last three consecutive financial years (FY 2022-23, 2023-24, and 2024-25)
- The annual average turnover of the Service Provider shall be at least INR 38,55,000 (30% of the annual contract value as per GO 57/18-2-2024-97 (L.U.)/2016 dated 26.11.2024) over the last three consecutive financial years, originating from Radiology and/or PET-CT scan services, in accordance with Government Order No. 57/18-2-2024-97 (L.U.)/2016 dated 26.11.2024, Clause 45.0. The certificate of Chartered Accountant to this effect duly signed and stamped on the Letter Head must be attached in the given format, annexed at Annexure C
- The service provider shall possess all valid registration documents to comply with statutory requirements, including registration with the appropriate authorities for operation of PET-CT facilities.

3. PROMINENT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The contract shall initially be awarded for a minimum period of five (05) years from the date of commencement, subject to annual performance review based on satisfactory reports submitted by the HOD Nuclear Medicine/MS/CMS of the Institute on such request and need of the Institute. Upon successful completion of the initial five-year period and subject to satisfactory performance, the contract may be extended for a further period of five (05) years for operation and Comprehensive Annual Maintenance Contract (CAMC) of the PET-CT machine, on mutually agreed terms and conditions.
2. Any renewal or extension of this Agreement shall be made in writing and shall incorporate the same terms and conditions as set forth in this Agreement, unless otherwise mutually agreed in writing by both Parties.
3. The PET-CT equipment shall remain under the manufacturer's warranty for an initial period of five (05) years, during which warranty-related maintenance and repairs shall be carried out by the Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM)/ Manufacturer as per warranty terms.
4. Either Party may unilaterally withdraw or terminate this Agreement by providing not less than ninety (90) days' prior written notice to the other Party.
5. If, in the opinion of Institute, the services provided by the Service Provider are found to be unsatisfactory, the Institute, shall issue a written notice specifying the deficiencies in service and grant- a notice period of thirty (30) days to the service provider, to rectify and improve its services
6. If the Service Provider fails to rectify or improve the services within the stipulated notice period of thirty (30) days period to the satisfaction of the Institute, the Institute shall have the right, at its sole discretion, to terminate this Agreement at any time after the expiry of the said notice period, without any further obligation
7. Any violation of Institute rules, code of conduct, or regulations by the Service Provider or its employees—inside or outside the premises—shall render the contract liable to termination with one month's notice
8. Overcharging beyond approved rates shall empower the Institute to terminate the contract with immediate effect
9. In the event of expiry, non renewal, termination, withdrawal of this Agreement, the Service Provider shall, upon request by the Institute, continue to provide services for a transitional period not exceeding 90 days, or until an alternate arrangement is made by the Institute, whichever occurs earlier. Such continued services shall be compensated at the same rates and terms specified in this Agreement.

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10. The Service provider will obtain all the required approval/ certificate to run the facility and shall consistently follow all the required guidelines including AERB Guidelines.
11. The Service Provider shall solely be responsible for compliance with all statutory obligations and shall indemnify the Institute against any liabilities arising therefrom.
12. The Service Provider shall be fully liable for any injury, accident, loss, or damage to its personnel, Institute property, or PET CT equipment, and shall indemnify the Institute against all related claims.
13. All personnel deployed shall have no criminal antecedents and shall have no claims whatsoever against the Institute.
14. The Service Provider shall make its own arrangements for transportation, accommodation (if any), and security passes for deployed personnel.
15. Sub-contracting is strictly prohibited.
16. Storage, supply, sale, or consumption of drugs, alcohol, tobacco, or intoxicants on the Institute campus is strictly prohibited.
17. The allotted premises shall be used exclusively for PET CT Scan services and vacated immediately upon termination.
18. The Service Provider shall operate strictly as per the EoI document, approved scope, timings, and directions of the Competent Authority.
19. Timings of operation shall be as approved by the Competent Authority (normally 8:00 AM to 08:00 PM, including Sundays and gazetted holidays, or as revised).
20. The Institute reserves the right to increase or decrease the scope of work, and any addition shall require prior approval
21. Institute officers shall have the right to conduct periodic and surprise inspections and obtain user feedback at any time.
22. The Service Provider or its authorized representative shall attend meetings convened by Institute authorities or committees.
23. All operational coordination shall be done with the CMS/MS or designated authority of the Institute.

4. GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Interested service providers are invited to apply for operation of the PET-CT Scan Machine for patient care under the Public-Private Partnership (PPP) model at KSSSCI, Lucknow. The selected Service Provider shall provide trained manpower to conduct PET-CT scan investigations outsourced by KSSSCI.
2. The Service Provider shall be responsible for providing all investigation services related to PET-CT scans at the point of care.
3. Test rates must be quoted at highly subsidized levels to serve poor and needy patients as a welfare measure for patients attending KSSSCI.
4. KSSSCI does not guarantee any minimum volume or quantity of work.
5. The Service Provider shall furnish complete particulars related to its legal status, constitution, and functioning.
6. The Service Provider shall ensure adherence to all ethical standards, maintain medical records, and comply with all applicable Government statutory requirements.
7. The Service Provider shall submit an undertaking confirming that the organization has not been blacklisted by any Government Department, Board, Corporation, or reputed private entity in the past.

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
9. The financial evaluation and final selection of the Service Provider, including consideration of the highest revenue share to the Institute and/or the L1 (lowest rate), as applicable, shall be carried out at a subsequent stage in accordance with applicable procurement procedures and evaluation criteria prescribed by the Institute.

11. The Institute reserves the right to amend, modify, or withdraw the EOI, in full or in part.
12. All premises and scheduled properties shall remain in the absolute possession of KSSSCI. The agreement shall only permit limited use of the allotted space for the agreed purpose and contract period.
13. In case the Service Provider fails to vacate the allotted premises upon expiry or termination of the contract (after one month's notice), a penal rent of ₹1,000 per day shall be levied, in addition to other applicable charges.

5. Security Deposit:

- i. Five percent (5%) of the total value of the annual contract as per GO 57/18-2-2024-97 (L.U.)/2016 dated 26.11.2024 which amounts to INR 6,42,500. Performance Security should be in form of Bank Guarantee/ Fixed Deposit Receipt, with validity of 63 months. The service provider shall ensure the extension of its validity for further 60 months, if the contract is extended. The Performance Security shall be submitted within 15 days from the date of letter issue to Successful Bidder. After submission of Performance Security Agreement shall be executed between Institute and Successful Bidder.
- ii. The Security Deposit may be made in the form of Bank Guarantee of any Scheduled Bank, in favor of Director, KSSSCI, Lucknow.
- iii. The security deposit shall be released, or refunded, as the case may be, only upon expiry of a period of 2 (two) months after the expiry of the contract or its earlier termination, as the case may be, after adjustment of all dues of the Institute or damages of any kind, if any and completion of all contractual obligations. The Institute shall be entitled to adjust any and every due amount from the said Security Deposit.
- iv. The security deposit would also stand forfeited, in its entirety, in case the Service Provider/Successful Bidder withdraws in violation of "Period of Contract".
- v. In case Bank Guarantee deposited as Security Deposited is invoked by Authority whether partially or fully, Service Provider shall replenish the Bank Guarantee within 03(three) days failing which Institute shall terminate the Contract.

6. Payment

1. All PET-CT investigation charges shall be deposited at the KSSSCI cash collection counters, in the same manner as other diagnostic investigations, with preference given to digital modes of payment. Applicable Service Tax/GST or any future statutory taxes shall be levied as per prevailing Government guidelines.
2. Separate receipts shall be issued for the PET-CT procedure and for contrast/consumables, respectively. Reimbursement towards PET-CT scan services shall be made to the Service Provider, while reimbursement towards consumables shall be credited to the Hospital Revolving Fund (HRF).
3. Bills pertaining to beneficiary schemes shall be raised separately, scheme-wise, by the Service Provider, along with submission of the corresponding PET-CT scan reports






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4. The Service Provider shall submit a monthly invoice (in triplicate) in the first week of every month for PET-CT services rendered during the preceding month, based on the number and type of procedures performed and the agreed revenue-sharing/financial model
5. Payment-related formalities shall be initiated only after mandatory validation of PET-CT reports by the competent authority. No payment shall be made for repeated or duplicate reporting at any stage.
6. Any clarification, dispute, or discrepancy in the submitted bills shall be resolved prior to release of payment.
7. Payment to the Service Provider shall be released subject to the following conditions:
 - a. Satisfactory performance of services
 - b. Certification of equipment uptime and image quality by the officer designated by the Institute
 - c. Submission of proof of compliance with statutory obligations
8. Under no circumstances shall payment be treated as a criterion for completion or closure of ongoing work




